- Instruct and act in accordance with the outcomes for each curriculum.
- Proven ability to follow lesson plans, organize academic activities, and display a state of preparedness with lesson materials.
- Recognize differences in learning styles and ascertain the placement of students according to their level of development in each subject.
- Positive approach that makes learning engaging and stimulates growth.
- Display a Christ-like attitude in relationships with students, parents, and staff.
- Reiterate faith lessons learned from books to teachable moments in the classroom and outside

- Aware of how the environment (indoor/outdoor) affects each student's learning.

Harvest Christian Academy believes in a setting that will be indoor/outdoor. Approximate schedule:

8:30am – Language Arts: Learning periods are 20 minutes each. This involves one grade doing a lesson with the teacher for 20 mins, while the other grade does quiet stations; then switch. Learning periods may be taught outside if it seems to fit with different students' learning styles or the content of the lesson.

9:45am – Gym time (15 mins unstructured, 20 mins structured), followed by 15 minutes for snack.

10:50am – Math: This second learning period involves one grade doing a math lesson with the teacher, while the other grade does quiet stations; then they switch.

11:35am - Craft time

12:10pm – Lunch: Students eat their lunch with their teacher in their classroom.

12:40pm Recess: One hour of free play outside run by volunteers. This is outdoors no matter the weather. At 1pm homeschool students join.

1:40pm – Story Time. This is outdoors in nice weather. One day per week the older class comes over for book buddies.

2:00pm – Quiet Time: Independent nature journaling or picture books while advanced students have read aloud turns with teacher. Some days they draw in their nature journal.

2:20pm - Social studies, science, art, or music.

3:00pm – Dismissal for students. Teachers must make sure students exit to their parents outside the office doors, and then guide the students on the "after school list" to the proper room.
